Mexico - Canada Trade January - April 2010 ¹

Trade Among NAFTA Partners

Region of North America:

- By April 2010, total trade in the NAFTA Region recorded a value of USD\$279 billion, equivalent to a growth of 31.3%, compared to the previous year's same period.
- In spite of this recovery, regional trade is still below the trade flows registered in 2008 (USD\$318.4 billion), the year before the crisis.
- As for the Mexico-Canada trade, flows increased 52.8% compared to last year, resulting in USD\$9.2 billion. This value represents a bilateral trade increase of almost 7 times during the NAFTA era, which also translates as an average annual growth rate of 12.9% between 1993 and 2010.
- Boosted by the drive of Mexican exports during April, bilateral trade not only recovered in 2010, but surpassed the exchange levels observed before the 2009 crisis (in April 2008, the Mexico-Canada trade was USD\$8.1 billion).
- In regard to Bilateral Trade between Mexico and the United States, the goods exchange increased 35.9%, amounting USD\$116.3 billion.

Mexico – Canada Trade:

- Up to April 2010, Mexico kept a trade surplus with Canada for USD\$3.8 billion, amount USD\$2 billion higher than the number registered back in April 2009.
- Mexico kept its position as Canada's 3rd greatest trade partner in the world, covering the Canadian market with 3.8%, after the United States (62.3%) and China (6.2%).
- Among the main trade partners of Canada, Mexico is in first place on trade growth (52.8%) by the fourth month of 2010, followed by the United Kingdom (43.2%) and United States (27%).

¹ The information contained in this report was developed using importer's numbers shown in official sources such as BANXICO, Statistics Canada and USDOC (in the section of trade by province, only data from Statistics Canada was used). Figures shown are in USD in accordance to the average nominal exchange rate observed in the mentioned period.

Comercio México – Canadá Enero - Abril 2010 ¹

Comercio entre los Países del TLCAN

Región de Norte América:

- Al mes de abril de 2010, el comercio total de la región TLCAN registró un valor de US\$279,000 mdd (millones de dólares estadounidenses), lo que representa un crecimiento de 31.3% respecto al mismo período del año anterior.
- No obstante el crecimiento observado, el comercio regional aún se encuentra por debajo de los niveles de 2008 (US\$318,470 mdd), año anterior a la crisis financiera.
- En cuanto al comercio México – Canadá, los flujos crecieron 52.8% comparado con 2009, ubicándose en US\$9,280 mdd. Este valor representa un crecimiento de casi 7 veces del comercio bilateral durante la era del TLCAN, traduciéndose además en una tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de 12.9% entre 1993 y 2010.
- Impulsado por el dinamismo de las exportaciones de México, el comercio bilateral no sólo ha logrado recuperarse en 2010, sino que además ha logrado superar los niveles de intercambio previos a la crisis de 2009 (en abril de 2008, el comercio México – Canadá fue de US\$8,199 mdd).
- En relación al comercio bilateral México-EE.UU., el intercambio de bienes creció 35.9%, registrando un valor de \$116,394 mdd.

Balanza Comercial México – Canadá:

- México mantiene superávit comercial con Canadá por US\$3,826 mdd, monto US\$2,052 mdd superior al registro en abril de 2009.
- A nivel mundial, México se ubicó como el tercer socio comercial de Canadá con el 3.8% del mercado canadiense, por debajo de EE.UU. (62.3%) y China (6.2%).
- Entre los principales socios comerciales de Canadá, México ocupa el primer lugar en crecimiento del comercio (52.8%) al cuarto mes de 2010, seguido por Reino Unido (43.2%) y EE.UU. (27%).

¹ Este reporte es elaborado utilizando las cifras del país importador publicadas por las fuentes oficiales de cada país: BANXICO, Statistics Canada y USDOC. En la sección de comercio por Provincia se utilizan únicamente datos de Statistics Canada. Los datos se presentan en dólares estadounidenses (USD) al tipo de cambio promedio nominal observado en el período indicado.

Exports from Canada to Mexico:

- Also, Mexico kept its position as Canada's 4th largest export market with 2.2% of Canadian sales, and was only exceeded by imports from the United States, the United Kingdom, and China.

- In terms of value, exports from Canada to Mexico reached USD\$2.7 billion, 726% higher than sales carried out in 1993. In spite of this strong recovery in 2010, the Mexican market value for Canadian products is still below the levels pre-crisis (USD\$3 billion in April 2008).

- The average annual growth rate of exports from Canada into Mexico between 1993 and 2010 is 13.2%.

Exports from Mexico to Canada:

- During April 2010, Mexico kept its position as the third greatest supplier for the Canadian market (5.4%), only exceeded by imports from the United States and China.

- Exports of Mexican products to Canada in January-April 2010 totaled USD\$6.5 billion, amount almost 7 times higher than the trade value registered in 1993 (USD\$845 million). The average annual growth rate of exports from Mexico into Canada from 1993 to 2010 was 12.8%.

Main Products

- The Mexican exported goods to Canada with a greater increase in April 2010 were: loading trucks, automobiles, auto-parts (engines and seats), telephone kits for cellular networks, petroleum, and tomatoes.

- In the case of television sets, the second main product exported by Mexico, after the fall registered in 2009 exports of this product increased 137% by April 2010.

Exportaciones de Canadá a México:

- México además se ubica como cuarto mercado de exportación para los productos canadienses (2.2% del total), por debajo de EE.UU, Reino Unido y China.

- En términos de valor, las exportaciones de Canadá a México se ubicaron en US\$2,727 mdd, monto 726% superior al monto registrado en 1993. A pesar de esta fuerte recuperación, el valor del mercado mexicano para los productos canadienses se encuentra aún por debajo de los niveles previos a la crisis (US\$3,093 mdd en abril de 2008).

- La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las exportaciones de Canadá a México entre 1993 y 2010 se ubica en 13.2%.

Exportaciones de México a Canadá:

- En abril de 2010, México mantuvo su posición como tercer proveedor de Canadá (5.4%), participación superada por las importaciones provenientes de EE.UU. y China.

- Las exportaciones de productos mexicanos a Canadá en enero - abril de 2010 sumaron US\$6,553 mdd, monto casi 7 veces superior en relación al comercio de 1993 (US\$845 mdd). La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las exportaciones mexicanas de 1993 a 2010 se ubicó en 12.8%.

Principales productos:

- Los bienes de exportación de México con un mayor crecimiento a abril de 2010 fueron: camiones para carga, automóviles, autopartes (motores y asientos), celulares, tractores, petróleo y tomates.

- En el caso de televisores, segundo principal producto de exportación de México, tras el desplome observado en 2009, las exportaciones de este producto se han incrementado en 137% en lo que va del año.

Investment from Canada in Mexico

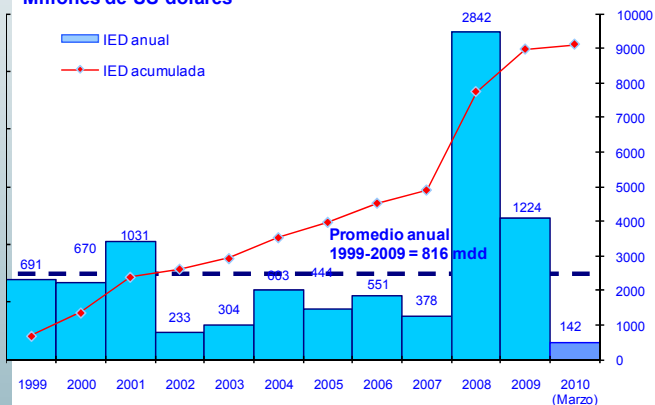
During the last fifteen years, Canadian foreign direct investment (FDI) has been a key factor for the integration of our productive sectors:

From January 1999 to March 2010, Canada's cumulative FDI in Mexico reached \$9.1 billion USD, becoming the fifth largest foreign investor in Mexico.

According to the Ministry of Economy, on March 2010, 2,480 firms were registered in Mexico as having Canadian capital.

These results demonstrate the high confidence that the NAFTA's legal framework has granted to Canadian investors to operate in Mexico.

Inversión de Canadá en México

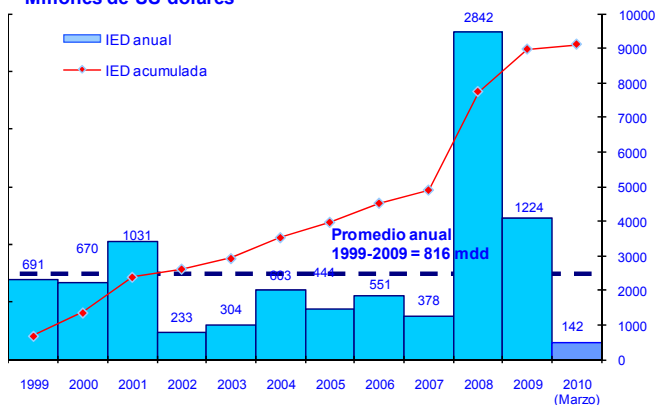
Durante los últimos quince años la inversión extranjera directa (IED) de Canadá ha sido un elemento clave para la integración de los sectores productivos de ambos países:

En el período enero de 1999 – marzo de 2010, la IED acumulada de Canadá en México alcanzó los US\$9,113 millones de dólares, lo que lo ubicó como el cuarto país inversionista en México

En marzo de 2010, 2,480 empresas se encontraban operando en México con participación de capital canadiense.

Estos indicadores comprueban el alto grado de confianza que el marco legal del TLCAN ofrece a los inversionistas canadienses para operar en México.

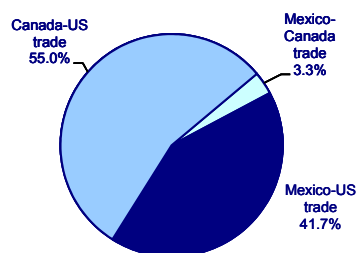

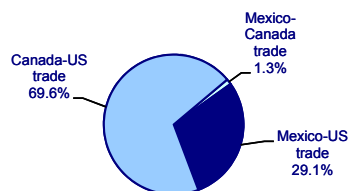

Trade Between NAFTA Partners (NAFTA trilateral trade growth January - April 10/93 = 199%)

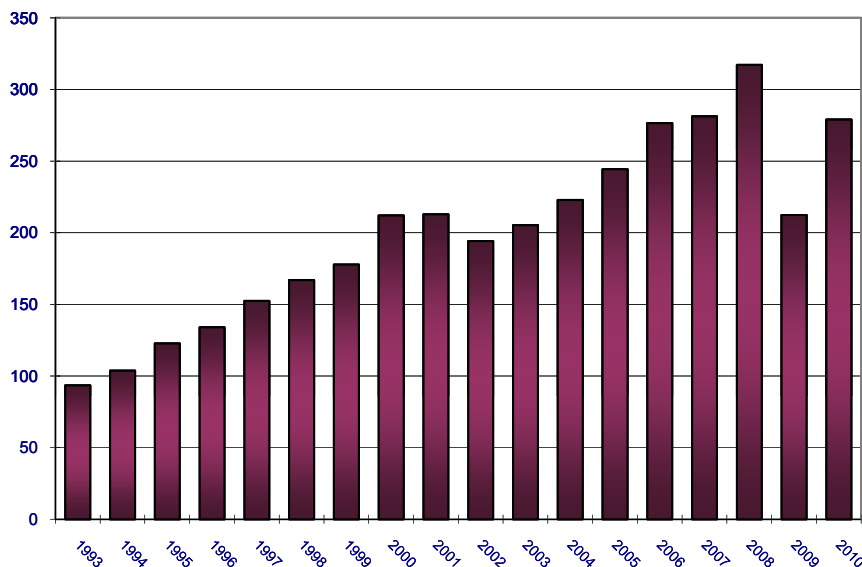

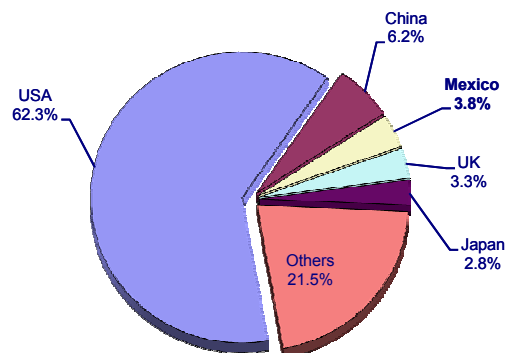

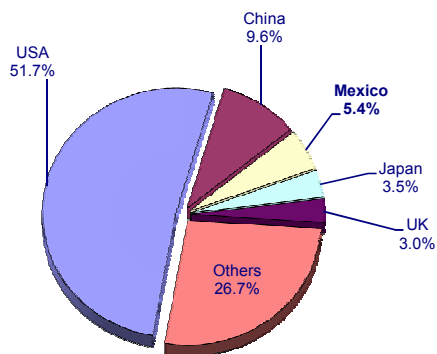

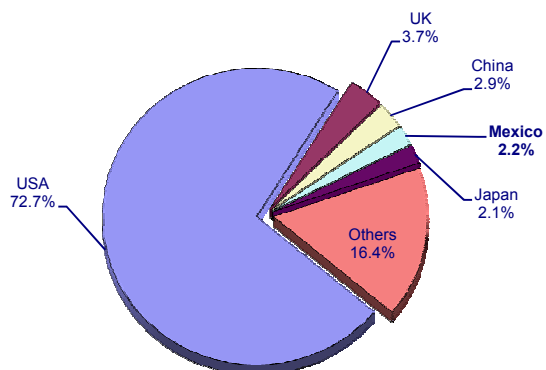
Canada's main trading partners

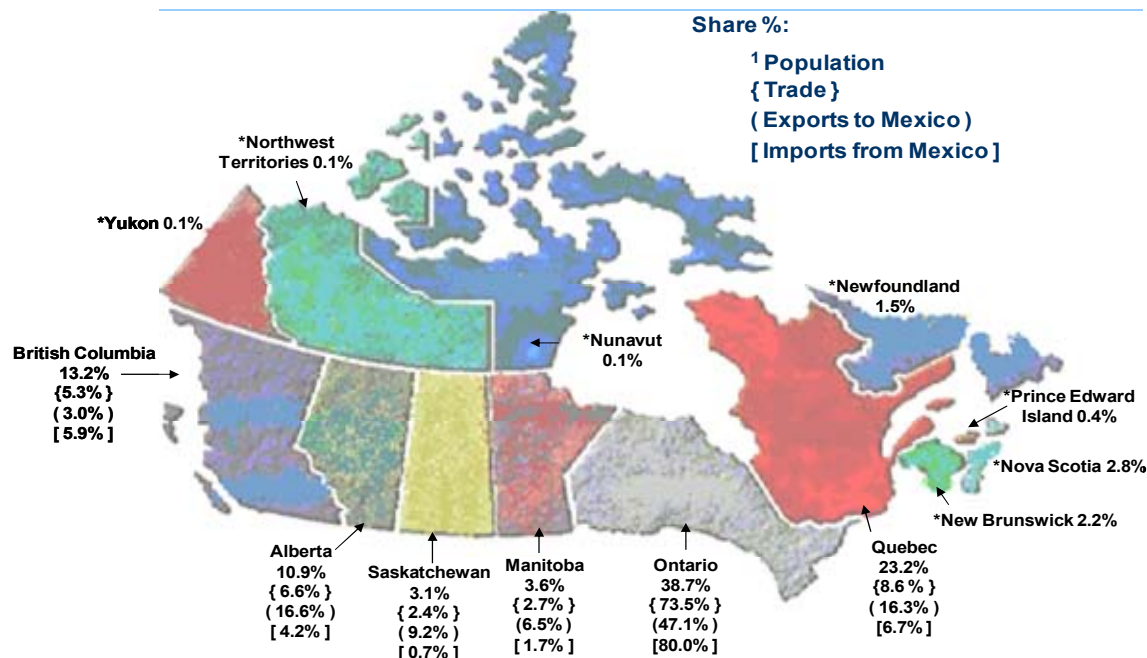
