MEXICO – CANADA TRADE JANUARY - JUNE 2010

Trade Among NAFTA Partners

Region of North America

- By the end of the first semester of 2010, total trade in the NAFTA Region recorded a value of **USD\$430.5 billion**, equivalent to a **growth of 33.6%**, compared to the previous year's same period.
- In spite of this recovery, because of the international financial crisis, **regional trade is still below the trade flows registered in 2008** (USD\$487.6 billion).
- As for the **Mexico-Canada trade, flows increased 52.1%** compared to the first semester of 2009, resulting in **USD\$14.2 billion**. This value represents a bilateral trade increase of **almost 7 times** during the NAFTA era, which also translates as an average annual growth rate of 12.8% between 1993 and 2010.
- Boosted by the powerful drive of Mexican exports, bilateral trade **not only recovered in 2010, but surpassed the exchange levels observed before the 2009 crisis** (in June 2008, the Mexico-Canada trade was USD\$12.7 billion).
- In regard to **Bilateral Trade between Mexico and the United States**, the goods exchange increased 37.5%, amounting **USD\$179.3 billion**.

Mexico – Canada Trade

- Mexico kept a trade surplus with Canada for **USD\$6.1 billion**, amount **USD\$3.2 billion higher** than the number registered back in June 2009.
- Mexico kept its position as Canada's **3rd greatest trade partner in the world**, covering the Canadian market with 3.8%, after the United States (62.6%) and China (6.4%).

1 The information contained in this report was developed using importer's numbers shown in official sources such as BANXICO, Statistics Canada and USDOC (in the section of trade by province, only data from Statistics Canada was used). Figures shown are in USD in accordance to the average nominal exchange rate observed in the mentioned period.

COMERCIO MEXICO – CANADA ENERO - JUNIO 2010

Comercio entre los países del TLCAN

Región de Norte América

- Al cierre del primer semestre de 2010, el comercio total de la región TLCAN registró un valor de **US\$430,536 mdd** (millones de dólares estadounidenses), lo que representa un **crecimiento de 33.6%** respecto al mismo período del año anterior.
- No obstante, resultado de la crisis financiera internacional, **el comercio TLCAN se encuentra por debajo de los niveles de 2008** (US\$487,668 mdd).
- En cuanto al comercio **México – Canadá, los flujos crecieron 52.1%** comparado con el primer semestre de 2009, ubicándose en **US\$14,222 mdd**. Este valor representa un crecimiento **de casi 7 veces** del comercio bilateral a lo largo de la era TLCAN, lo que además representa una tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de 12.8% entre 1993 y 2010.
- Impulsado por el fuerte dinamismo de las exportaciones, el comercio México - Canadá **no sólo ha logrado recuperarse en 2010, además ha superado los niveles de intercambio observados antes del inicio de la crisis** (en junio de 2008, el comercio México – Canadá fue de US\$12,774 mdd).

- En relación al **comercio bilateral México-EE.UU.**, el intercambio de bienes creció 37.5%, registrando un valor de **\$179,396 mdd**.

Balanza Comercial México - Canadá

- México mantiene superávit comercial con Canadá por **US\$6,131 mdd**, monto **US\$3,252 mdd** superior al registro en junio de 2009.
- A nivel mundial, México se ubicó como el **tercer socio comercial** de Canadá con el 3.8% del mercado canadiense, por debajo de EE.UU. (62.6%) y China (6.4%).

Canadian Exports to Mexico:

- **In June 2010, Mexico** lost its 4th place, which was taken by Japan, as the largest export market for Canadian sales. Mexico, in **position number 5** with 2.1% from the total, was only exceeded by imports from the United States, the United Kingdom, and China.

- In terms of value, **exports from Canada to Mexico** reached **USD\$4 billion**, almost 700% higher than sales carried out in 1993. In spite of this strong recovery in 2010, the Mexican market value for Canadian products is still **below the levels pre-crisis** (USD\$3.2 billion in June 2008).

- The average annual growth rate of **exports from Canada into Mexico** between 1993 and 2010 is **13.0%**.

Mexican Exports to Canada:

- During June 2010, Mexico kept its position as the **3rd greatest supplier for the Canadian market** (5.4%), only exceeded by imports from the United States and China.

- Exports of **Mexican products to Canada** in June 2010 totalled **USD\$10.1 billion**, amount equivalent to **6 times higher than the trade value registered in 1993** (USD\$1.3 billion). The average annual growth rate of **exports from Mexico into Canada** was **12.7%**.

Main Products:

- The Mexican exported goods to Canada with a greater increase during the first semester of 2010 were: loading trucks with loads between 5 and 20 tons, semi-trailer tractors, automobiles with engine between 1500 and 3000 cc, auto-parts (ignition cables and seats), crude oil, electronic products (telephone kits for cellular networks), tractors and tomatoes.

- During June 2010, a recomposition of the main products exported to Canada took place. For this month, the main products were: 5 tons loads (or less) loading trucks, followed by automobiles and television sets. In the same period back in 2009, television sets were the first main product exported by Mexico. This exports structure recomposition was the result of the strong growth of exports of trucks and automobiles related to the same period in 2009 (316% and 120.4%, respectively).

Exportaciones de Canadá a México:

- **En junio de 2010 México** perdió la cuarta posición frente a Japón y representa el **quinto mercado de exportación** para los productos canadienses (2.1% del total), por debajo de EE.UU, Reino Unido, China y Japón.

- En términos de valor, las **exportaciones de Canadá a México** se ubicaron en **US\$4,046 mdd**, monto casi 700% superior al registrado en 1993. A pesar de esta fuerte recuperación, el valor del mercado mexicano para los productos canadienses se encuentra **aún por debajo de los niveles previos a la crisis** (US\$3,235 mdd en junio de 2008).

- La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las **exportaciones de Canadá a México** entre 1993 y 2010 se ubica en **13.0%**.

Exportaciones de México a Canadá

- A junio de 2010, México mantuvo su posición **como tercer proveedor de Canadá** (5.4%), participación superada por las importaciones provenientes de EE.UU. y China.

- Las exportaciones de productos mexicanos a Canadá en mayo sumaron **US\$10,177 mdd**, valor equivalente a **más de 6 veces las exportaciones registradas 1993** (US\$1,339 mdd). La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las exportaciones mexicanas se ubicó en **12.7%**.

Principales productos:

- Los bienes de exportación de México con un mayor crecimiento durante el primer semestre de 2010 fueron: camiones para carga de entre 5 y 20 toneladas, tractores para semirremolques, automóviles con motor entre 1500 y 3000 cc, autopartes (cables para encendido y asientos), petróleo crudo, productos electrónicos (celulares), tractores, y tomates.

- Durante el mes de junio, se dio una recomposición de los principales productos exportados a Canadá. Para este mes, el principal producto es camiones para carga máxima inferior o igual a 5 toneladas, seguido por automóviles y televisiones. En el mismo periodo del 2009 las televisiones ocuparon el primer lugar. Esta recomposición en la estructura de las exportaciones fue resultado del fuerte crecimiento en las exportaciones de camiones y automóviles en relación al mismo período de 2009 (316% y 120.4%, respectivamente).

Investment from Canada in Mexico

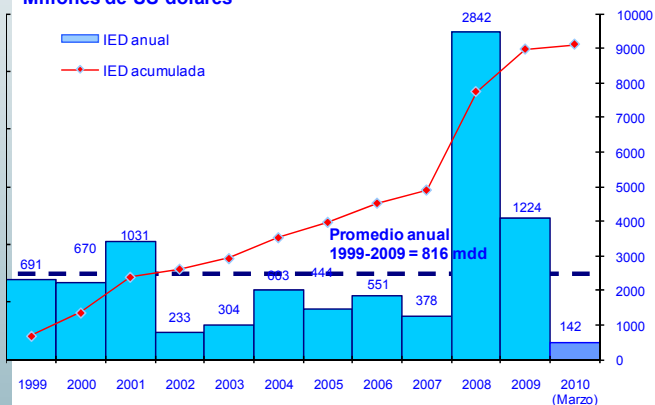
During the last fifteen years, Canadian foreign direct investment (FDI) has been a key factor for the integration of our productive sectors:

From January 1999 to March 2010, Canada's cumulative FDI in Mexico reached \$9.1 billion USD, becoming the fifth largest foreign investor in Mexico.

According to the Ministry of Economy, on March 2010, 2,480 firms were registered in Mexico as having Canadian capital.

These results demonstrate the high confidence that the NAFTA's legal framework has granted to Canadian investors to operate in Mexico.

Inversión de Canadá en México

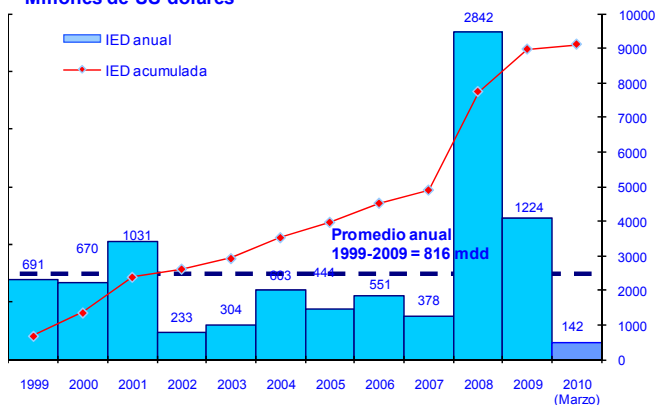
Durante los últimos quince años la inversión extranjera directa (IED) de Canadá ha sido un elemento clave para la integración de los sectores productivos de ambos países:

En el período enero de 1999 – marzo de 2010, la IED acumulada de Canadá en México alcanzó los US\$9,113 millones de dólares, lo que lo ubicó como el cuarto país inversionista en México

En marzo de 2010, 2,480 empresas se encontraban operando en México con participación de capital canadiense.

Estos indicadores comprueban el alto grado de confianza que el marco legal del TLCAN ofrece a los inversionistas canadienses para operar en México.

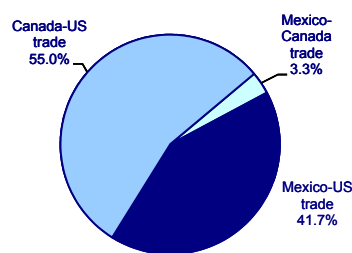

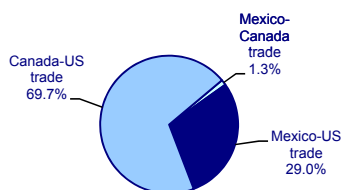

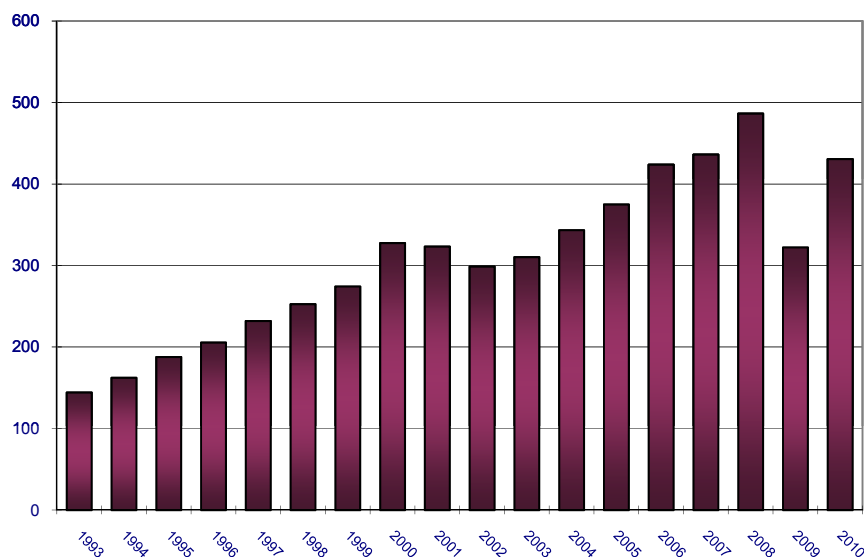
2010

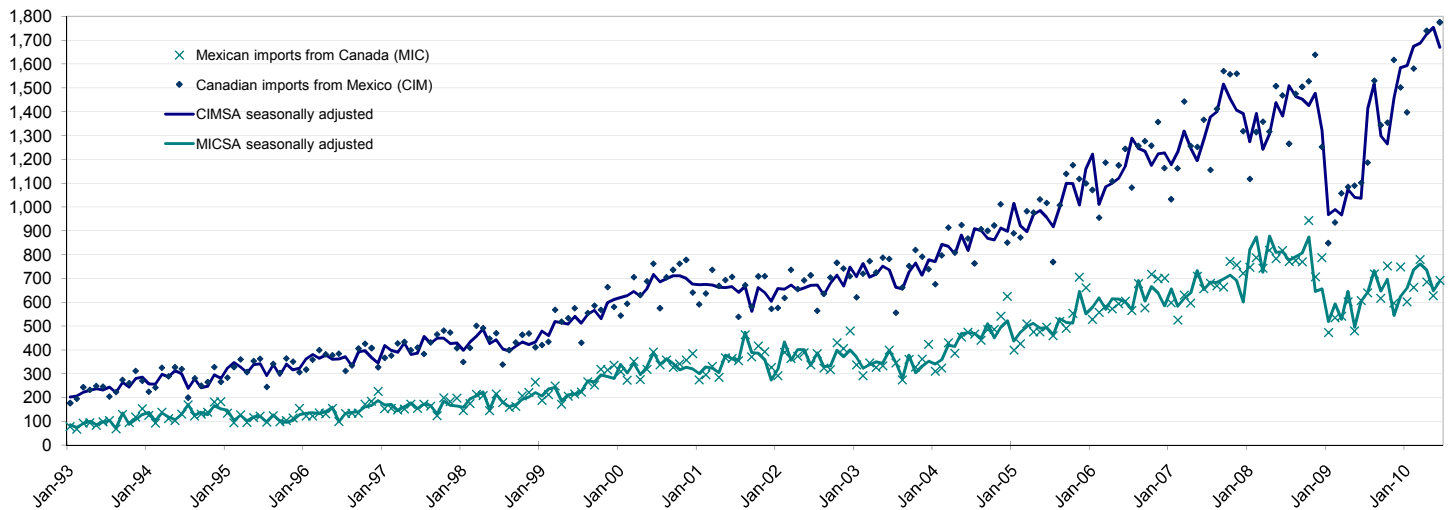

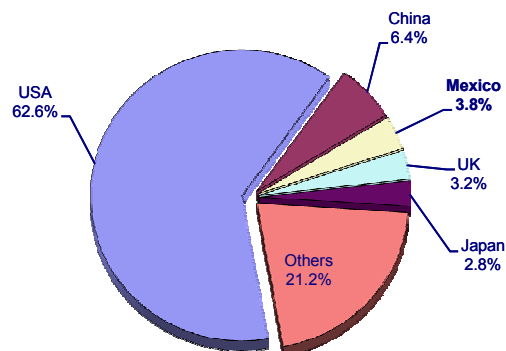

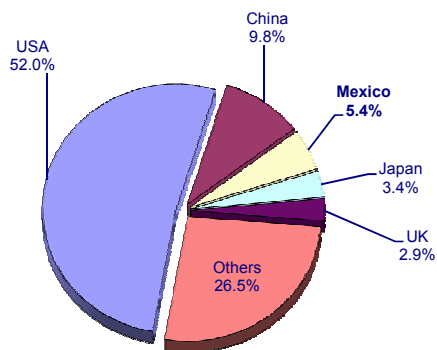

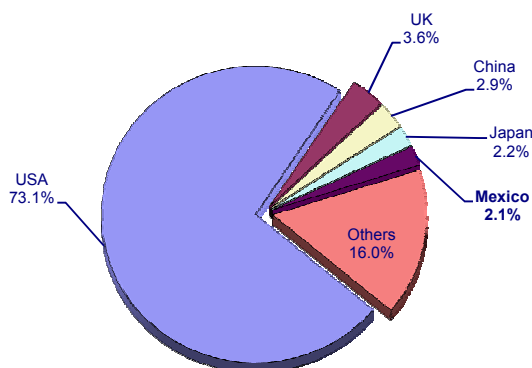
**Canada's main trading partners

189.8 billion of US dollars)**



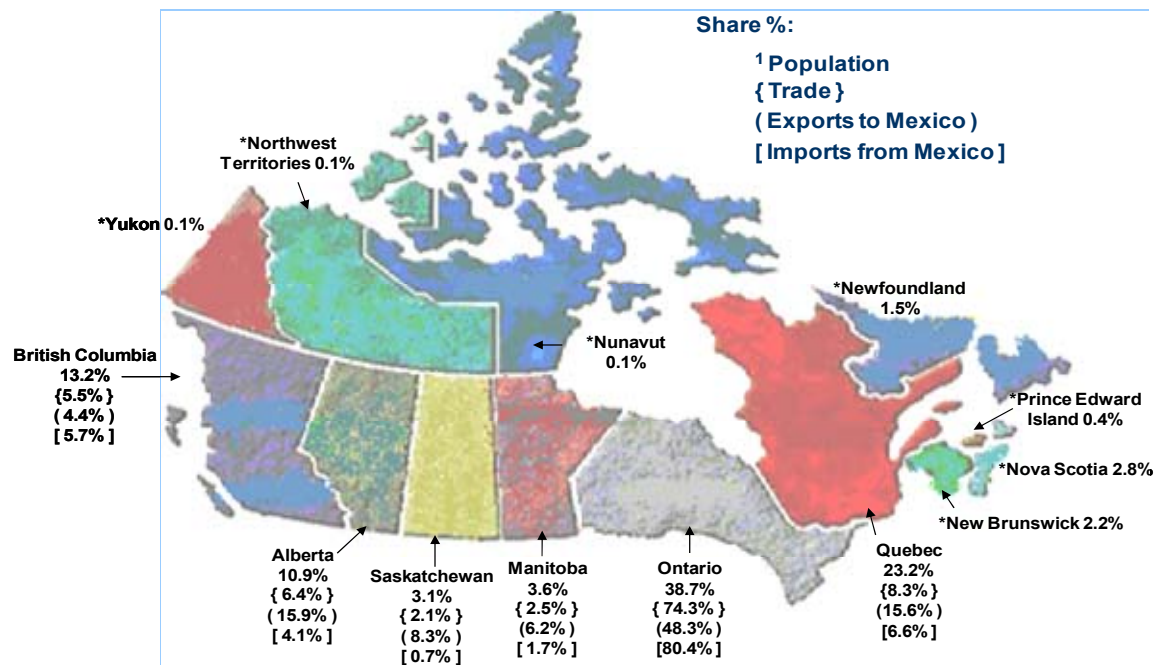
