MEXICO – CANADA TRADE 2007

Bilateral Trade

- Between January and December 2007, the Mexico-Canada trade reached the \$24.1 billion US dollars, 11.9% higher than the figure shown in the same period in 2006. Furthermore, this value is five times higher than the trade number recorded during the same period in 1993 (\$4.1 billion USD), which is equivalent to an average annual growth rate of 13.6% in the NAFTA age.

NAFTA Trade

During 2007, the trilateral trade in North America increased 5.8% with regard to the same period last year, resulting in \$894.4 billion US dollars. As for the bilateral exchange of Mexico-United States, it increased in a 6.9% during 2007 compared to last year, resulting in \$351.4 billion US dollars.

Trade Balance

By the end of 2007, the Mexico-Canada trade exchange recorded a surplus in favour of Mexico of \$8.1 billion US dollars, \$1.4 billion higher than the same period in 2006.

Canadian Exports to Mexico

- During 2007, Mexico became the Canada's fifth exporting market, exceeded by sales to United States, United Kingdom, China and Japan.
- As for value, exports from Canada into Mexico reached the \$7.9 billion US dollars, 578.5% and 8.1% higher than sales carried out in 1993 and 2006, respectively.
- The average annual growth rate of exports of Canada into Mexico, for the period of 1993 to 2007, was registered in a 14.7%.

Mexican Exports to Canada

- As 2007 ended, Mexico became the third supplier of Canada, gaining the 4.2% from the Canadian imports market value, percentage only exceeded by imports of United States (54.1%) and China (9.4%).
- In this way, sales of Mexican products in Canada came to \$16.1 billion US dollars, an amount 458.5% higher than the number in 1993 and 13.9% higher than the sales of Mexico in Canada carried out during 2006.
- The average annual growth rate of exports from Mexico into Canada for years 1993 to 2007 was 13.1%.

COMERCIO MEXICO – CANADA 2007

Comercio Bilateral

En el período enero-diciembre de 2007, el comercio México-Canadá alcanzó los \$24,060 millones de dólares (mdd), monto 11.9% superior al valor observado durante el mismo período de 2006. Este valor además es cinco veces superior al valor de comercio registrado en 1993 (\$4,056 mdd), lo que equivale a una tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de 13.6% en la era TLCAN.

Comercio TLCAN

Durante 2007, el comercio trilateral en América del Norte aumentó 5.8% con respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior, ubicándose en \$894,362 mdd. Por su parte, el intercambio bilateral de México-EE.UU. se incrementó en 6.9% durante 2007 respecto al año anterior, ubicándose en \$351,369 mdd.

Balanza Comercial

Al cierre de 2007, el intercambio comercial México-Canadá registró un superávit a favor de México por \$8,110 mdd, \$1,359 mdd superior al observado en el mismo lapso de 2006.

Exportaciones de Canadá a México

- Durante 2007, México se ubicó como el quinto mercado de exportación para Canadá, siendo superado por las ventas realizadas a EE.UU, Reino Unido, China y Japón.
- En términos de valor, las exportaciones de Canadá a México alcanzaron los \$7,975 mdd, 578.5% y 8.1% superiores a las ventas realizadas en 1993 y 2006, respectivamente.
- La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las exportaciones de Canadá a México para el período 1993 - 2007 se ubicó en 14.7%.

Exportaciones de México a Canadá

- Al finalizar 2007, México se ubicó como el tercer proveedor de Canadá al capturar el 4.2% del valor del mercado canadiense de importaciones, porcentaje superado sólo por las importaciones provenientes de EE.UU (54.1%) y China (9.4%).
- De esta forma, las ventas de productos mexicanos en Canadá sumaron \$16,085 mdd, monto 458.5% superior respecto a 1993 y 13.9% mayor a las ventas de México en Canadá realizadas durante 2006.
- La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las exportaciones de México a Canadá para los años 1993 a 2007 se ubicó en 13.1%.

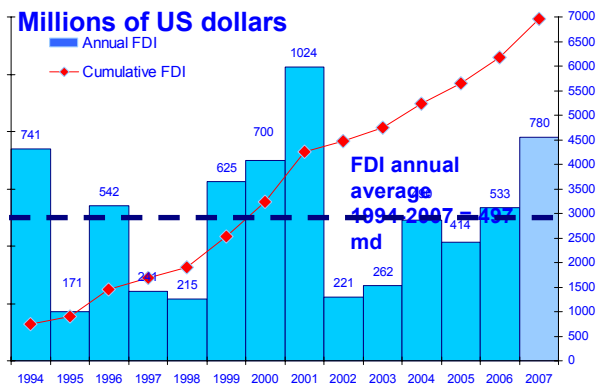
Investment from Canada in Mexico

During the last fourteen years, Canadian foreign direct investment (FDI) has been a key factor for the integration of our productive sectors:

- From January 1994 to December 2007, Canada's cumulative FDI in Mexico reached US\$6.9 billion, becoming the fifth largest foreign investor in Mexico.
- According to the Ministry of Economy, on December 2007, 1,961 firms were registered in Mexico as having Canadian capital.

These results demonstrate the high confidence that the NAFTA's legal framework has granted to Canadian investors to operate in Mexico.

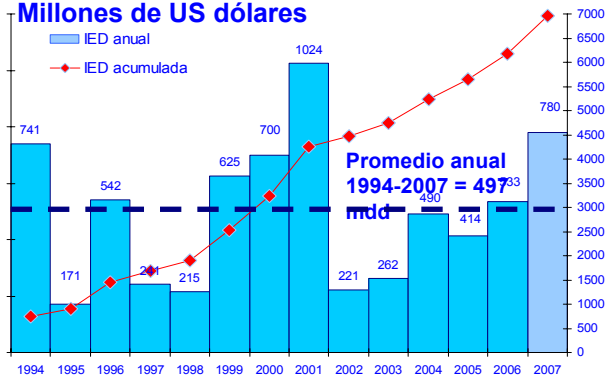
Inversión de Canadá en México

Durante los últimos catorce años la inversión extranjera directa (IED) de Canadá ha sido un elemento clave para la integración de los sectores productivos de ambos países:

- En el período enero de 1994 – diciembre de 2007, la IED acumulada de Canadá en México alcanzó los US\$6,958 millones de dólares, lo que lo ubicó como el quinto país inversionista en México.
- En Diciembre de 2007, 1,961 empresas se encontraban operando en México con participación de capital canadiense.

Estos indicadores comprueban el alto grado de confianza que el marco legal del TLCAN ofrece a los inversionistas canadienses para operar en México.

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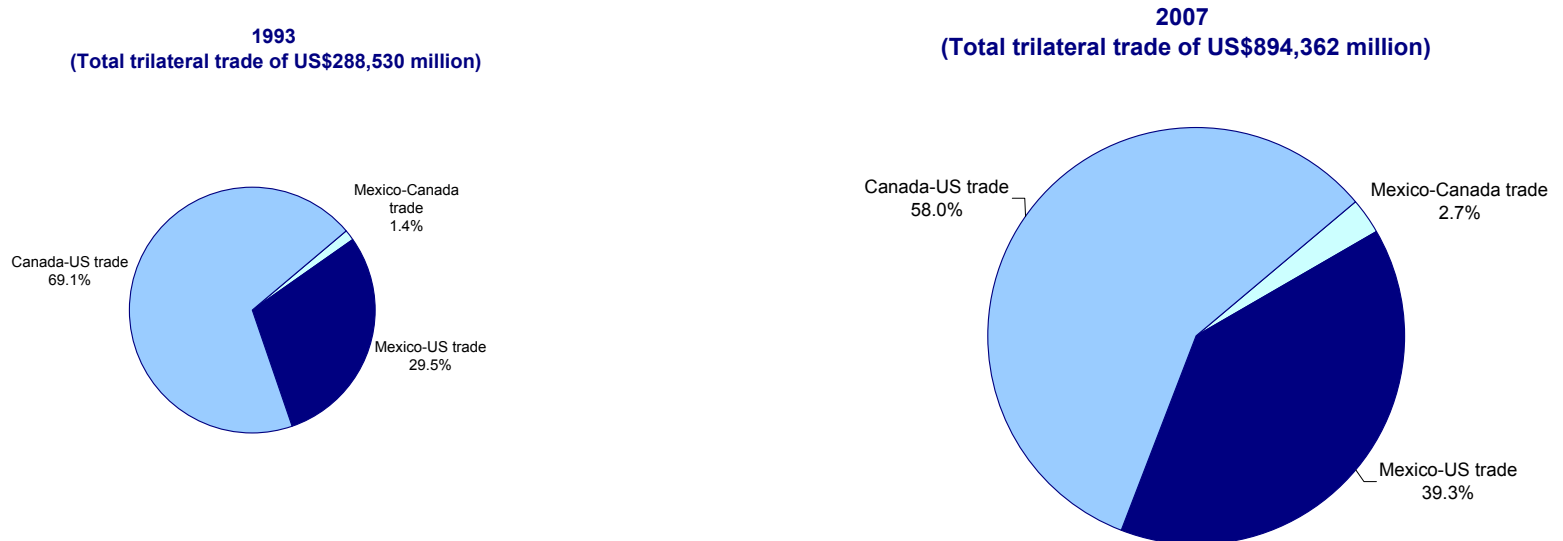

Trade Between NAFTA Partners (NAFTA trilateral trade growth 2007/1993 = 210%)



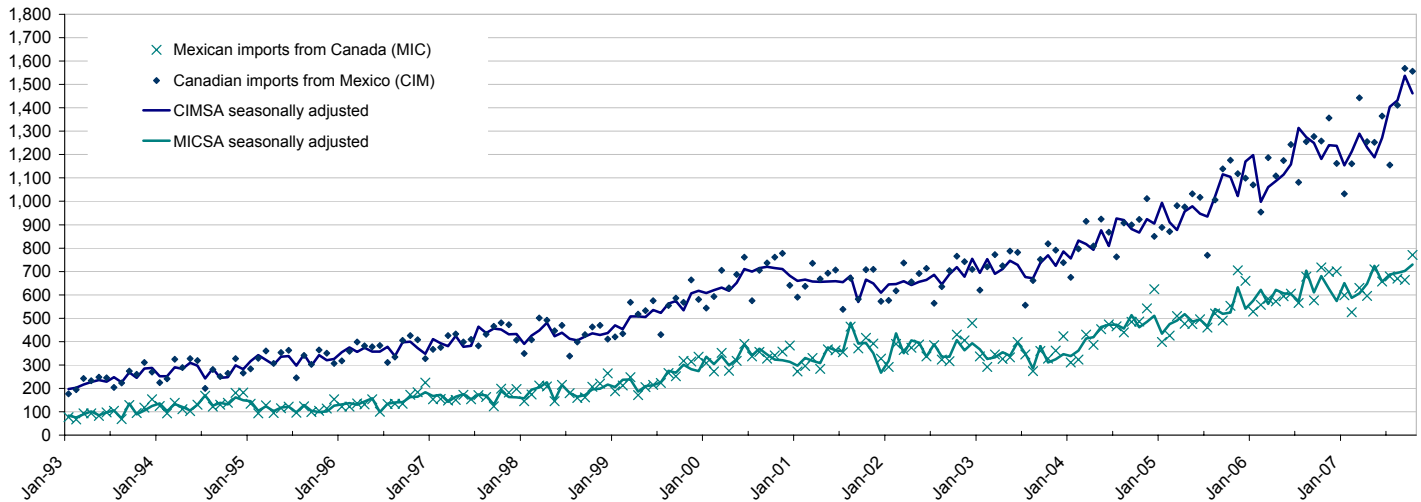

(millions of US dollars)

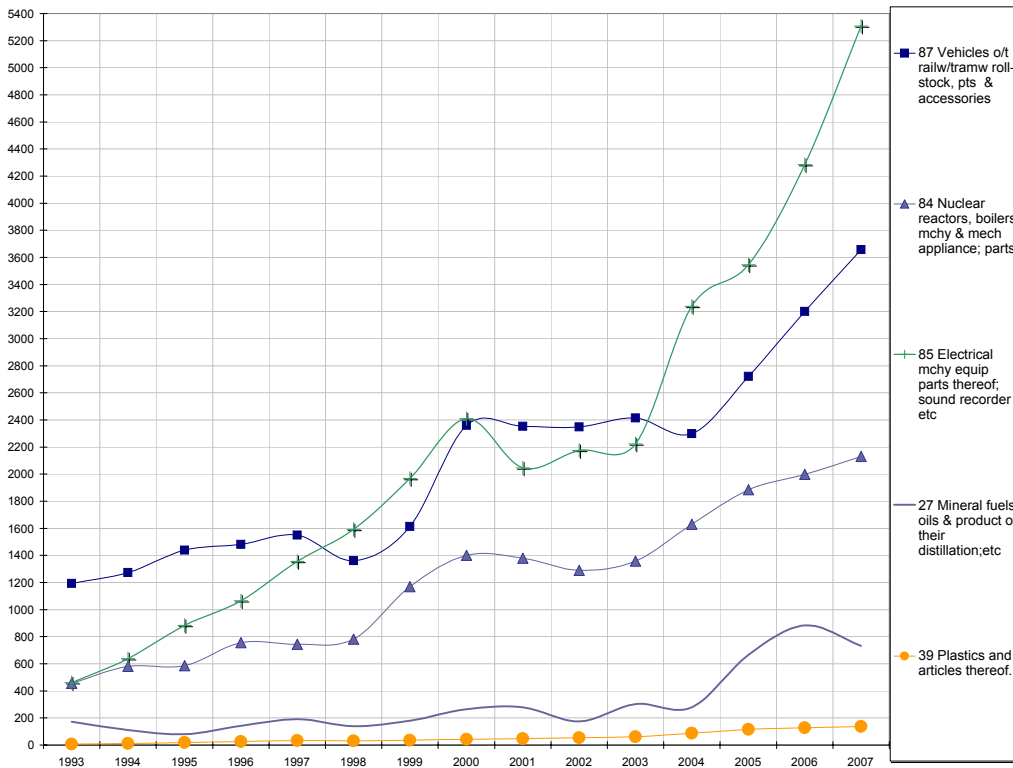

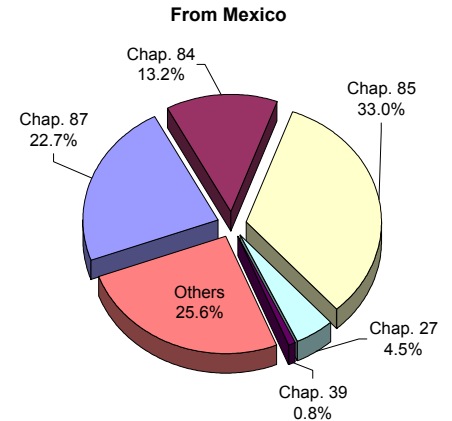

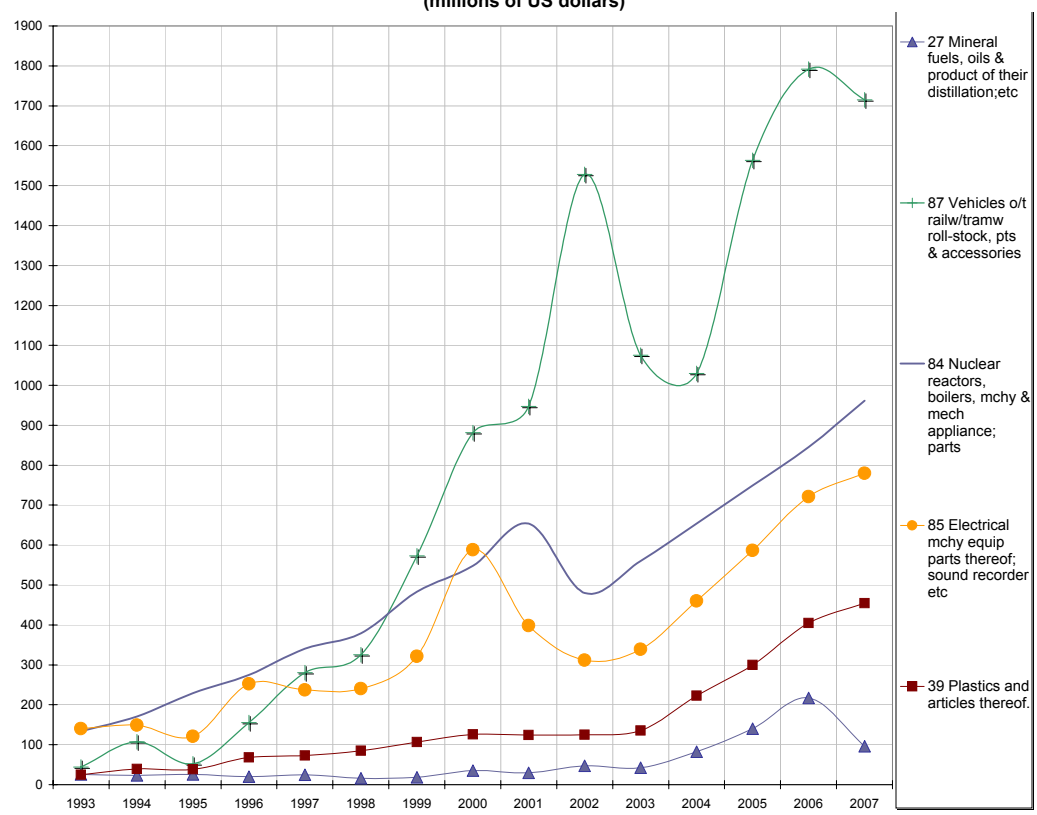

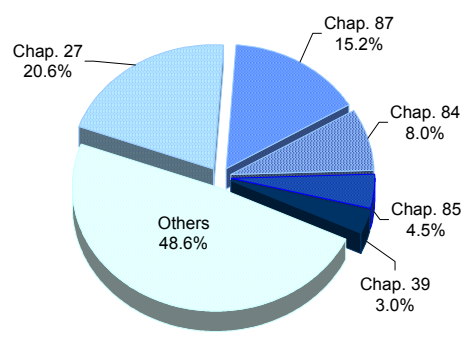

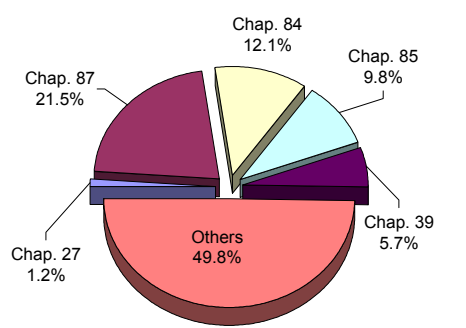
Canada's Top 5 Exports by HTS Chapter:

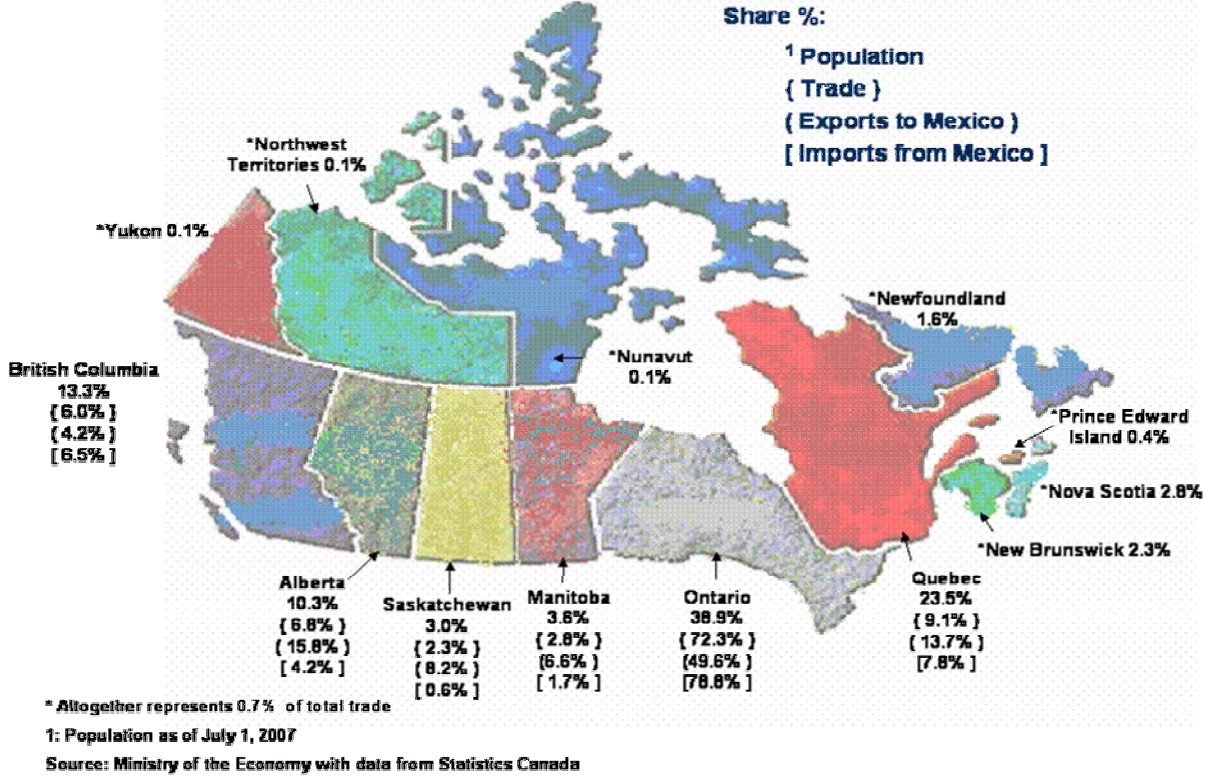

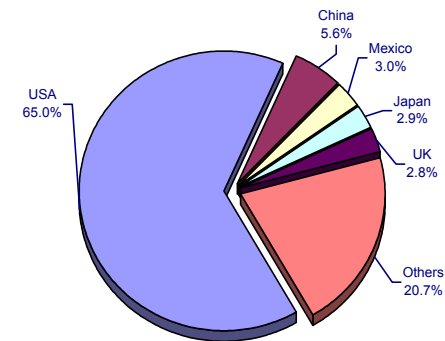

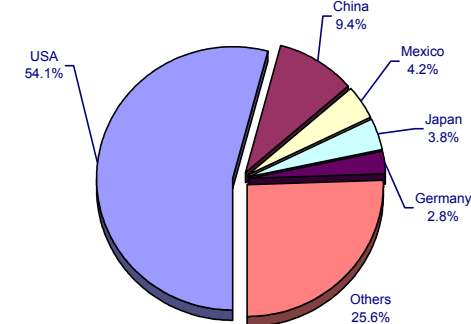
