MEXICO-CANADA TRADE 2011

Trade Among NAFTA Partners

Region of North America

- In 2011 total trade in the NAFTA Region recorded a value of **USD\$1,011.7 billion**, equivalent to a **growth of 15%** in comparison to the same period last year, thus reaching a ***historic level record in regional trade.***
- Within the North American block, Mexico's trade with the U.S. and Canada has increased from 30.9% of the total of the region in 1993, to 46.6% in 2011, reflecting the importance of Mexico as a trading partner.
- As for **bilateral trade between Mexico and Canada, flows grew 14.6%**, resulting in **USD\$34.4 billion, a historic level record in the bilateral relationship.** This value represents a trade increase of **751%**, during the NAFTA era, which can also be read as an average annual growth rate of 12.6% between 1993 and 2011, **the highest of the region.**
- **Between 2009 and 2011, trade between Mexico and Canada increased 63.9%**, allowing a quick recovery after the steep drop registered in 2008, caused by the recent recession.
- Regarding the **bilateral trade between Mexico and the United States**, the goods exchange increased **16.7%**, amounting **USD\$437.4 billion.**

Mexico – Canada Trade Balance:

- Mexico increased its **trade surplus** with Canada by **18%**, going from **USD\$12.8 billion** in 2010, to **USD\$15.1 billion** in 2011.
- Mexico ranked as Canada's **3rd largest trade partner in the world**, covering **3.8% of the Canadian market**, with the United States being in the first position with 59.8% and China in second with 7.3%.
- Among Canada's major trading partners, the growth of trade with Mexico reached the second highest level (14.6%), surpassed only by China.

COMERCIO MÉXICO-CANADÁ 2011

Comercio Entre los Países del TLCAN

Región de Norte América

- En 2011 el valor del comercio total de la región TLCAN fue de **US\$1,011,734 mdd** (millones de dólares estadounidenses), lo que representa un **crecimiento de 15%** comparado con el mismo período del año anterior ***el nivel histórico más alto en el comercio regional.***
- Dentro del bloque de Norteamérica, el comercio total de México con sus países socios pasó del 30.9% del total de la región de 1993 al 46.6% en 2011, lo que refleja la importancia de México como socio comercial para Canadá y EE.UU.
- En la relación **México – Canadá, los flujos comerciales crecieron 14.6%**, ubicándose en **US\$34,469 mdd, cifra récord en la relación bilateral.** Este valor representa un crecimiento del comercio de **751%** en la era del TLCAN, lo que además se traduce en una tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de 12.6% entre 1993 y 2011, **la más alta para la región.**
- **De 2009 a 2011, el comercio México – Canadá ha crecido 63.9%**, permitiendo una rápida recuperación después de la fuerte caída registrada al cierre de 2008, resultado de la recesión global.
- En relación al **comercio México-EE.UU.**, el intercambio de bienes creció **16.7%**, para ubicarse en **\$437,462 mdd.**

Balanza Comercial México - Canadá

- **El superávit comercial de México se incrementó en 18%**, al pasar de **US\$12,861 mdd** a **US\$15,179 mdd** en 2011.
- A nivel mundial, México se mantuvo como el **tercer socio comercial de Canadá** con el 3.8% del mercado canadiense, por debajo de EE.UU. (59.8%) y China (7.3%).
- Entre los principales socios comerciales de Canadá, el crecimiento del comercio con México alcanzó el segundo nivel más alto (14.6%), superado únicamente por China.

Exports from Canada to Mexico

- By December 2011, **Mexico** was ranked the **5th largest export market** for Canadian products (2.1% from total), only after the United States, United Kingdom, China and Japan.
- In terms of value, **exports from Canada to Mexico** reached **USD\$9.6 billion**, an amount 721% higher than sales recorded in 1993.
- The average annual growth rate of **exports from Canada into Mexico** between 1993 and 2011 is **12.1%**.

Exports from Mexico to Canada

- On a province level, Mexican exports to Nova Scotia increased 216%, 42% to Alberta, and 32.3% to Saskatchewan. In contrast, exports to Quebec, second provincial destination for Mexican products, fell by 8.5% in comparison to 2010.
- In 2011, Mexico kept its position as the **3rd largest supplier for the Canadian market** (5.5%). This participation was only exceeded by imports from the United States and China. Mexico held the same position in 2010.
- Exports of **Mexican products to Canada** in 2011 totalled **USD\$24.8 billion**, which is **more than 8 times the sales of 1993** (USD\$2.8 billion). The average annual growth rate of exports from Mexico to Canada was **12.7%**.

Main products

- Canada's top exports to Mexico in 2011 were: colza seeds, automobiles, aluminum alloys, wheat, and bars and rods of alloy steel.
- The top ten products that Mexico exported to Canada in 2011 make 38.5% of the total. Emphasis is made on the export growth of spark plug wire sets used in transportation vehicles (22.5%), vehicles with motor with more than 3,000 cm³ (21.5%), computers (17.4%) and cellular phones (9.4%).

Exportaciones de Canadá a México

- **México** concluyó el año como **quinto mercado de exportación** para los productos canadienses (2.1% del total), misma posición que en 2010, por debajo de EE.UU, Reino Unido, China y Japón.
- En términos de valor, las **ventas de Canadá a México se ubicaron en US\$9,645 mdd**, monto 721% superior al monto registrado en 1993.
- La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las **exportaciones de Canadá a México** entre 1993 y 2011 se ubica en **12.1%**.

Exportaciones de México a Canadá

- A nivel provincia, las exportaciones mexicanas a Nueva Escocia crecieron 216%, 42% a Alberta y 32.3% a Saskatchewan. En contraste, las ventas a Quebec, segundo destino provincial para productos de México, cayó 8.5% en relación a 2010.
- En 2011, México mantuvo su posición como **tercer proveedor de Canadá** (5.5%), participación superada por las compras de Canadá a EE.UU. y China. México ocupó este mismo sitio en 2010.
- Las exportaciones de productos mexicanos a Canadá en 2011 sumaron **US\$24,824 mdd**, monto equivalente a **más de 8 veces el valor respecto 1993** (US\$2,876 mdd). La tasa de crecimiento anual promedio de las exportaciones mexicanas en la época del TLCAN se ubicó en **12.7%**.

Principales productos

- Los bienes de exportación de Canadá con mayor penetración en el mercado mexicano durante 2011 fueron: Semillas de nabo o colza, automóviles, aleaciones de aluminio, trigo y barras y perfiles de acero aleados.
- Los diez principales productos que México exportó a Canadá en 2011 agrupan el 38.5% del total. En el sector manufacturero, destacan los crecimientos en las exportaciones de juegos de cables para bujías utilizados en los medios de transporte (22.5%), automóviles con motor de más de 3,000 cm³ (21.5%), computadoras (17.4%) y teléfonos celulares (9.4%).

Investment from Canada in Mexico

During the last eleven years, Canadian foreign direct investment (FDI) has been a key factor for the integration of our productive sectors:

From January 2000 to December 2011, Canada's cumulative FDI in Mexico reached \$11.1 billion USD, becoming the fourth largest foreign investor in Mexico after USA, Spain and Netherlands.

According to the Ministry of Economy, on December 2011, 2,897 firms were registered in Mexico as having Canadian capital.

These results demonstrate the high confidence that the NAFTA's legal framework has granted to Canadian investors to operate in Mexico.

Inversión de Canadá en México

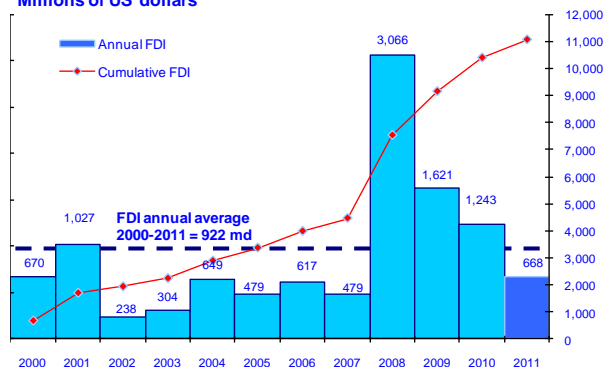
Durante los últimos once años la inversión extranjera directa (IED) de Canadá ha sido un elemento clave para la integración de los sectores productivos de ambos países:

En el período enero de 2000 – diciembre 2011, la IED acumulada de Canadá en México alcanzó los US\$11,062 millones de dólares, lo que lo ubicó como el cuarto país inversionista en México después de EE.UU., España y Países Bajos.

En diciembre de 2011, 2,897 empresas se encontraban operando en México con participación de capital canadiense.

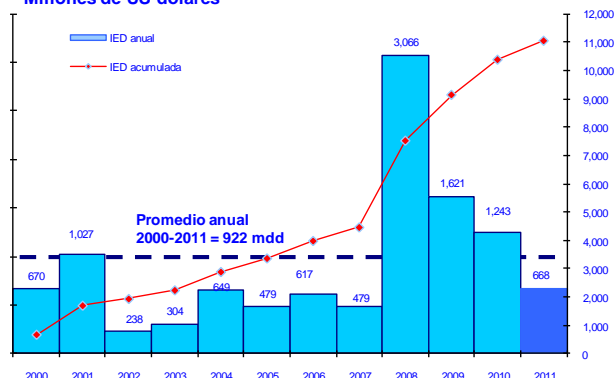
Estos indicadores comprueban el alto grado de confianza que el marco legal del TLCAN ofrece a los inversionistas canadienses para operar en México.

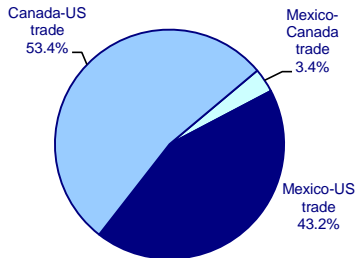

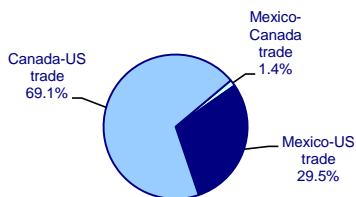

Trade Between NAFTA Partners (NAFTA trilateral trade growth (11/93 = 250%))

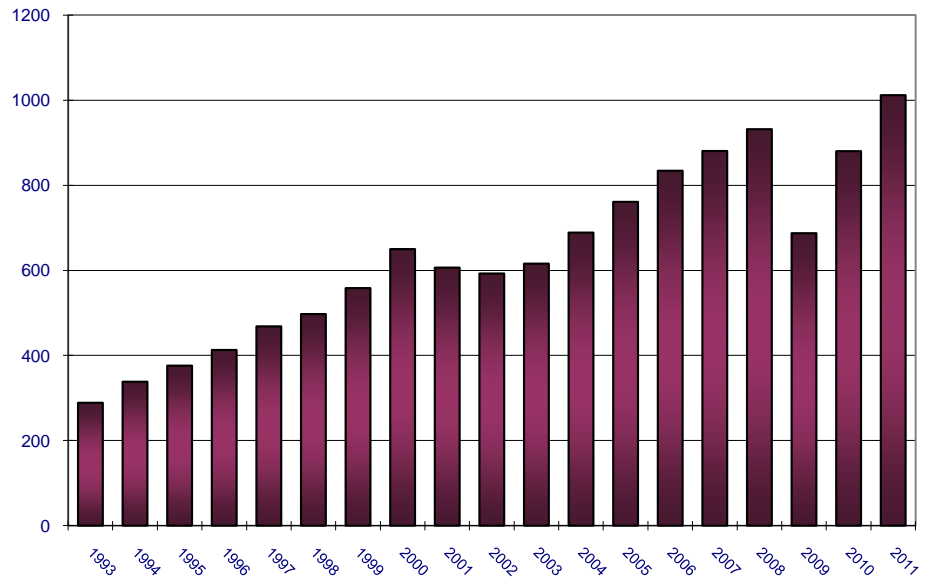

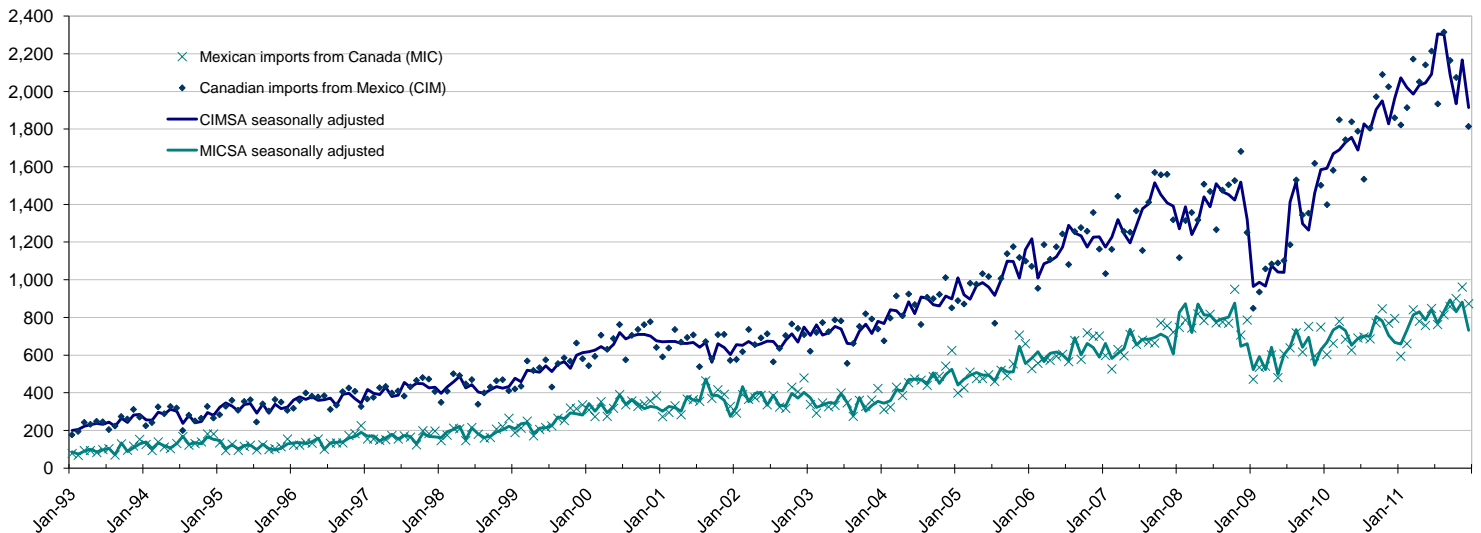

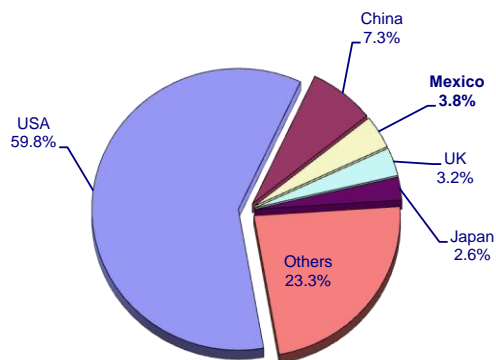

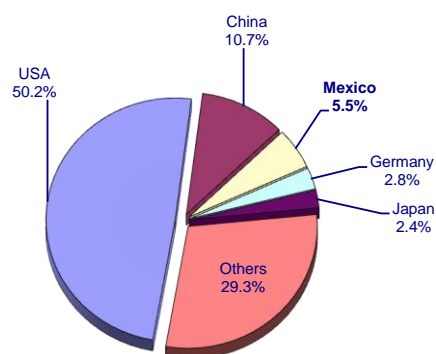

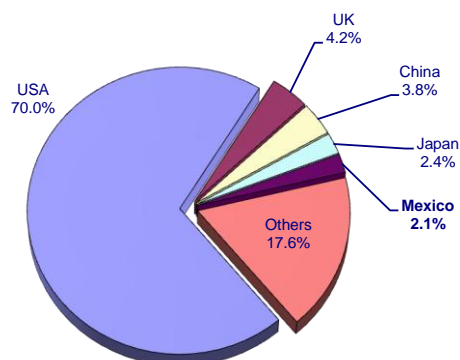
**Canada's main trading partners

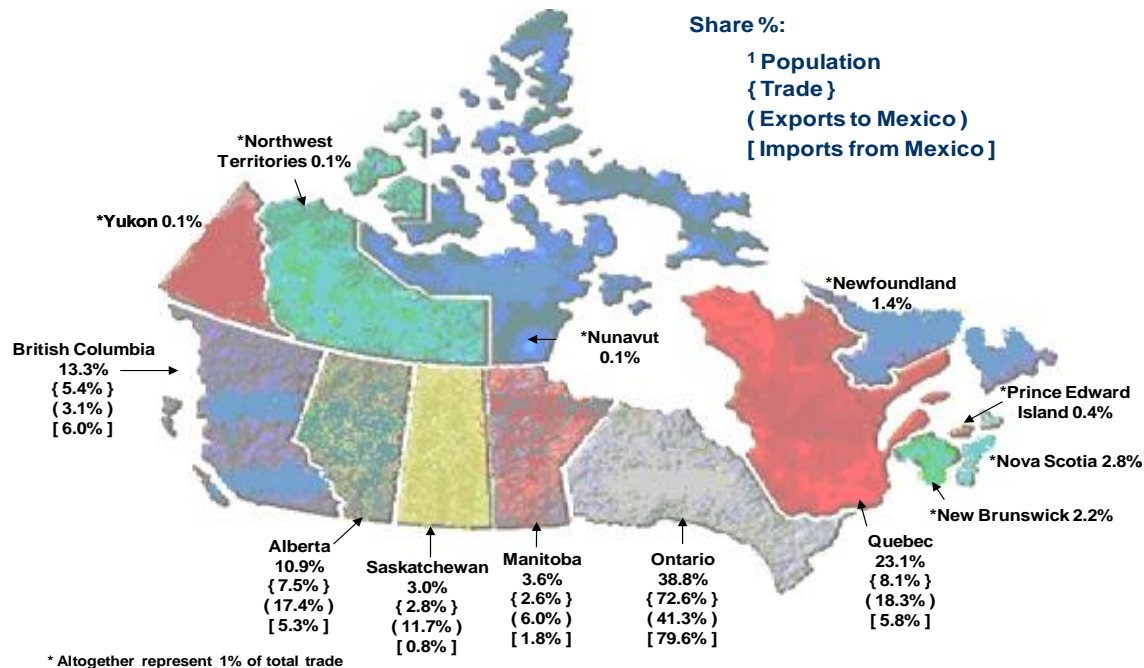
